



# CALL TO ARTISTS PUBLIC ART PROJECT



**Deadline: Noon on Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

The Edmundston Arts Center is looking for proposals from artists, groups, and arts organizations, to participate in a public art project that will take place in Edmundston this fall. Artists are invited to install temporary or permanent contemporary artworks, in public spaces, including works from the visual arts (painting, sculpture, performance, installation, etc.) and the literary arts (poetry, essays, etc.), as well as cultural mediation activities (workshop, discussion with the artist, etc.).

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## TERMS OF SUBMISSION

- Location:** Edmundston, especially downtown and outdoors  
**Timeframe:** October to December 2020  
**Honorarium:** According to CARFAC rates, conditional on budget approval  
**Eligibility:** Professional and/or emerging artists  
**Priority:** Candidates from and/or living in the Edmundston region or New Brunswick and/or engaged in a professionalization process and/or recognized by their peers.

### Proposal Content

The proposal must include:

1. Contact details (name, phone number, email, postal address)
2. Detailed description of the project (one page maximum)
3. Artistic statement (one page maximum)
4. Arts curriculum vitae and/or biography
5. Media clippings (optional)
6. Digital images and/or videos of artworks in JPG format (maximum of ten)
7. Detailed list of images/videos (title, year, medium and dimensions)

### Evaluation Criteria

- Artistic merit - 50%
- Meets priorities - 30%
- Professionalism of the proposal - 10%
- Ability to complete the project - 10%

### Selection Process

1. Proposals will be assessed by the Edmundston Arts Centre, represented by the project curator, and in partnership with the Galerie Colline.
2. The Centre reserves the right to invite a potential candidate to submit a proposal after the closing deadline, in the case that received proposals are insufficient in number, deemed ineligible or non-priority and/or with a preliminary assessment under the 70% mark.
3. The Centre reserves the right to make the final decision in order to ensure a balance between different artistic styles, techniques, and philosophies, and for a fair representation of official languages, genders, cultural communities and the strategic objectives of the Centre.
4. Only selected candidates will be contacted.
